GRAND RAPIDS COMBINED THEATRE SCHOLARSHIPS

The purpose of the Grand Rapids Combined Theatre Scholarship Fund is to award college/university level scholarships to students from the Greater Grand Rapids, Michigan Metropolitan Area pursuing a course of study in the theatre arts, thereby encouraging and assisting those student to pursue a professional career in some aspect of the theatre arts. The scholarship fund was founded in 1985 by Grand Rapids community theatres.

<u>Amount of Awards</u>: Scholarships generally ranging from **\$1,000 to \$2,000** are awarded annually to individuals who by their own contribution to theatre have demonstrated ability, talent, and dedication to the theatre arts.

Application Requirements: Applicants must:

1) Be enrolled full time, or applying for full time enrollment, in an accredited college/ university course of study in some aspect of the theatre arts located within the United States. No award will be paid prior to full time enrollment.

2) Have theatre arts training and experience, including experience in one or more community theaters located in and serving the Greater Grand Rapids, Michigan Metropolitan Area.

3) Submit an Application on the form provided that includes:

- a resumé of all theatre arts related experience and training, including but not limited to all community theatre experience;
- an essay discussing the Applicant's interest in the theatre arts; how that interest has grown and developed; and the Applicant's goals and aspirations for future theatre arts involvement;
- three letters of recommendation from people with first hand knowledge of the Applicant's involvement in some aspect of theatre arts;

4) If requested, submit to an in-person or virtual interview by the Scholarship Fund.

<u>Award Payment</u>: Awards will be paid directly to the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment. This is an annual competitive award. Previous applicants and recipients may reapply in subsequent years.
