The Grand Rapids Community Foundation administers and awards the following Law Scholarship to students of color

The Miller Johnson Michigan Diversity Scholarship is awarded a student of color currently pursuing a law degree at an accredited law school within the US who either has permanent residence in Michigan or attend a Michigan law school. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. One \$5,000 scholarship is awarded each year.

<u>Award Payment</u>: Awards will be paid directly to the recipient's school and upon verification of enrollment. This is an annual competitive award and is not renewable. Awards are announced in mid-May and payments are processed during the month of June and are not available until July.
